SAF's Walker Guest House Replica

SAF raised over \$250,000 to construct a full-scale Replica of the 1952 Paul Rudolph-designed Walker Guest House on the grounds of The Ringling Museum. The house was open daily with SAF volunteer docent-led tours for over 58,000 visitors from November 2015 through April 2017.

For the past three months, SAF has been in discussion with Palm Springs Modern Committee to exhibit the Walker Guest House Replica at the October 2018 and February 2019 desert Modernism events. A high-visibility building site has been selected, and the not-for-profit organization is developing plans to open the fully furnished Replica for public tours and private events. The exhibition is expected to draw many thousands of visitors and generate significant media coverage in the centennial of architect Paul Rudolph's birth. Pending a review of the Replica's seismic integrity, similar to what SAF did to meet Florida's hurricane requirements, an agreement is expected to be completed in the next six weeks. The previously planned installation at the University of Miami's School of Architecture did not move forward, primarily due to local building code issues. SAF-SRQ.org/WalkerGuestHouse

SAF-Paul Rudolph Scholarship Awards

Since 2012, SAF has awarded \$36,262 to twelve Florida high school graduates. The annual SAF-Paul Rudolph Scholarships, totaling \$6,000, provide financial assistance to students enrolled in an NAAB-accredited degree in architecture. 2018 scholarship applications are due May 21, 2018. Preservation Advocacy

Blue Pagoda (Chamber of Commerce) 1957, Architect Victor Lundy

SAF partnered with architect Greg Hall, AIA, Hall Architects, who donated his services on SAF's behalf, and advised the City of Sarasota during the stage one renovation.

Sarasota High School Canopy Walkway, 1958–1960, Architect Paul Rudolph

After a ten-month negotiation, the Sarasota County School Board and SAF announced an agreement to restore and preserve the Rudolph Walkway Canopy. SAF Board Member Dr. Michael Kalman and *Sarasota Magazine* Founder Emeritus Dan Denton each donated \$15,000 to the \$34,000 project budget, with the remainder coming from SAF's preservation fund. SAF will have a formal ceremony in February/March 2018 and install two plaques, explaining the architectural significance of the covered walkway.

South Gate Community Center, 1956, Architect Victor Lundy

SAF facilitated site visits and donated fees for a restoration report by architect Greg Hall, AIA, Hall Architects and engineer Steve Wilbur, Stirling & Wilbur Engineering Group. The report will be used to develop a plan to raise funds for building improvements.

Special Recognition

American Institute of Architects Florida/Caribbean chapter awarded the 2017 Bob Graham Architectural Awareness Award to SAF board member Janet Minker, for her work in "advocating, educating and celebrating the Sarasota School of Architecture movement, [and] working to preserve its midcentury modern structures." The award is named for former Florida Governor and U.S. Senator Bob Graham whose interest in architecture led AIA-Florida to make him an honorary member.
